Abstracts are limited to 300 words, excluding title, authors, and affiliations and must be submitted as a Word Document using the template available on our website.

Abstracts should include:

- Title
- Last name and initial of all authors
- Email of corresponding author
- Affiliation
- Abstract format: Background & Purpose, Methods, Results, Discussion/Conclusion. Do not include references or tables.

The main author must choose in which of the following categories the abstract is submitted:


- Clinical

- Evaluation
- Program description
- Policy

ABSTRACT DEADLINE: May 20th 2018

All abstracts will be peer-reviewed by the Scientific Committee as part of the selection process. Notification of acceptance or rejection will be made via e-mail by June 10th 2018.

Accepted abstracts will be assigned to Oral or Poster walk presentations according to the decision of the Scientific Committee, which is final.
